TENDER NOTICE

The Kenya Urban Roads Authority (KURA) is a State Corporation in the Ministry of Roads and Transport; established under the Kenya Roads Act, 2007 with the core mandate of Management, Development, Rehabilitation and Maintenance of National Urban Road Network.

As a leading Government Agency with the above mandate, KURA wishes to invite bids from eligible construction companies for road works as described below to be funded through the Road Maintenance Levy as listed below:

Interested bidders **MUST** be registered with the National Construction Authority (NCA) road works categories as indicated below:-

Bidders may examine and obtain detailed tender documents during normal working hours, from the Supply Chain Management Office on Ground floor Barabara plaza, upon payment of a non-refundable fee of Kshs. 1,000 (Kenya Shillings One Thousand Only) for each document in form of a **Banker's Cheque** payable to the **Kenya Urban Roads Authority**. The same information may be accessed in the websites at www.kura.go.ke/tenders and www.tenders.go.ke. Bidders will be required to attach a copy of an official receipt to the bid document when submitting as proof of payment. For those who will download the document, they will be required to provide their details by registering at the Supply Chain Management Office on Ground floor Barabara plaza, Block D immediately after the site visit and before submitting the documents.

The bidders are expected to include the following in their bids:-

- (a) **Certified Copy of Certificate of incorporation;**
- (b) **Certified Copy of VALID Registration Certificate with the National Construction Authority in the categories specified above and Valid Practicing License;(Proof of renewal is acceptable)**
- (c) **A copy of VALID Tax Compliance Certificate (Will be verified on the KRA TCC Checker);**
- (d) **Certified Copy of RECENT CR12 form generated through the system -(at most 6 months before bid opening date) from Registrar of Companies; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;**
- (e) **Bidders shall sequentially serialize all pages for each tender document submitted; failure to which the bidder shall be disqualified;**
- (f) **Certified copy of a valid certificate of registration in a target group issued by the National Treasury or the respective County Treasury in the relevant category (Youth, Women & PWD).**

Note:

- ❖ Certification of documents shall be original and executed by a **Commissioner for Oaths or issuing institution.**
- ❖ Submitted Documents by the Bidders **shall be subjected to Due Diligence** from the originating sources and shall be used for recommendation or disqualification depending on the outcome;
- ❖ Bidders are advised to provide active Email addresses and contact details of the provided documents to facilitate communication, failure to which the bidders shall be disqualified.
- ❖ All interested bidders are required to continually check the KURA website www.kura.go.ke/tenders for any tender addenda or clarification that may arise before the submission date.
- ❖ To enhance equity, bidders shall bid for a maximum of **Two (2)** tenders but can only be awarded one tender. Bidders who participate in more than two tenders shall be disqualified.
- ❖ Bidders to ensure that their rates in the Bills of Quantities are within the known prevailing market rates for road works Pursuant to Section 54 (2) of the PPADA, 2015 read together with Regulation 43 (4) of PPADR, 2020.
- ❖ The Cost Estimation Manual 2022-2023 Popular Edition from KRB will be used as a market survey guide to inform on the award of tenders. Bidders can refer to the KRB website www.krb.go.ke

The criteria of evaluation of bids

The criteria shall be as described in the tender documents.

Description of Works

The description and scope of works is as described in the tender documents.

Site Visits

There shall be no organized site visits. Bidders are however required to appraise themselves with the site conditions before bidding and complete the certificate of Tenderer's site visit.

Prices quoted should include all taxes and must be expressed in Kenya Shillings and shall remain valid for a period of **210 days** from the date of tender opening.

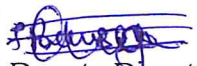
